### ABOUT Q81



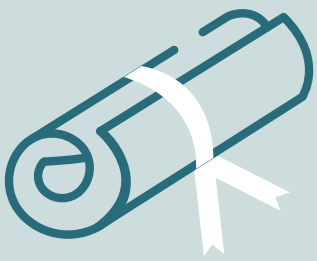
The Anquan Boldin Foundation, better known as Q81, was founded in 2004 and is going on 17 years of service to families. The Foundation's ongoing emphasis has been on providing educational opportunities for their community.

### ACADEMIC RECOVERY

For over 10 years, the Q81 Summer Enrichment Program has mentored more than 400 high school students from The Glades area as they successfully complete course forgiveness prior to graduation. More than half of these students have continued on to college.



### COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIPS



In 2014, Anquan & Dionne Boldin personally funded a \$1 million endowment displaying their sincere commitment towards underserved students. The foundation has committed over \$300K in academic scholarships to 19 college students who display a dedication to community service, academic achievement and display a need for support.

Of those 19 scholarship recipients, 18 students have graduated from college. The most recent example is Fernando Azor who just recently graduated from dental hygienist school.
